The Directive 2008/96/CE on road infrastructure safety management has been implemented by Italy with Legislative Decree no. 35 dated 15/03/2011, regulates the monitoring of projects during various stages of planning, inspections on the existing roads, classification of network security and training of road safety experts.

The Decree deals with roads of national interest that are part of the trans-European road network (TEN-T), while for the other roads the provisions have to be intended as guidelines.

From 1st of January 2016, the discipline will be extended to the remaining roads of national interest, not included in the TEN-T.

Within December 2020, Regions and Autonomous Provinces, in accordance with the principles established by the Decree, will define the rules concerning the management of road infrastructure safety responsibility of the Regions and Local Authorities.

The Decree provides the rules for a gradual implementation of the Directive to the whole national road system, in order to use the first assessment of the results on the TEN-T network as a basis for the further implementation in rest of the national and local network

The secondary road network is characterized by higher accident rates than the main roads and is the network on which we should act more effectively.

In this context, the Lazio Region, through ASTRAL (Lazio Roads Company), is the Italian partner, together with Greece, Spain, Denmark and the Czech Republic, in a pilot initiative called Pilot4Safety, co-financed by the European Commission and coordinated by FEHRL (European Federation of National Road Research Laboratories), which aims to use the Directive as a template for road safety operations on secondary roads.

The project aims to share good practices of Road Safety Audits and Road Safety Inspections between European regions, define common curricula for road safety experts, with practical application on secondary roads.
